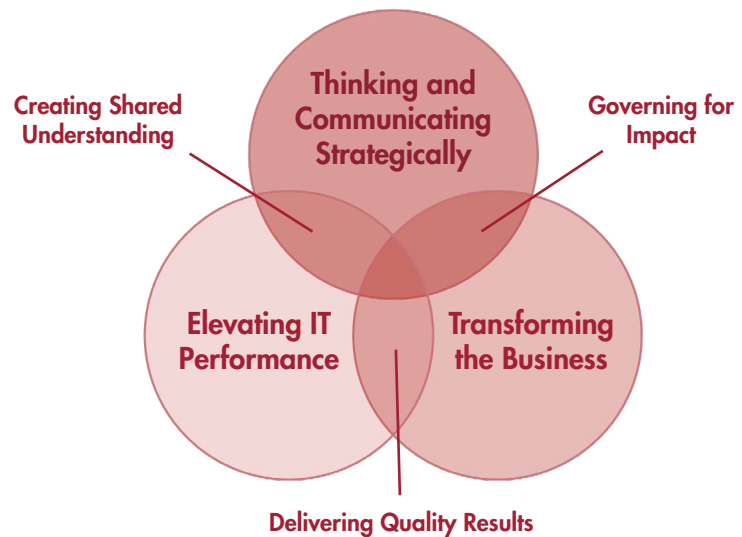


# FUTURE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER PROGRAM

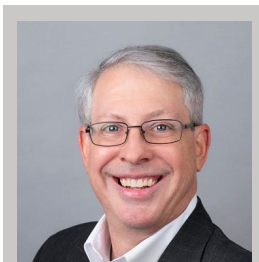
## PROGRAM BENEFITS
